This last month I read Mothers, Daughters, and Body Image: "Learning to Love Ourselves as We Are" by Hilary L. McBride. This book is laced with stories of women who are trying to fight against the cultural norms of beauty and combat the shame that comes with comparison. This book also included steps on how to train our brains to do better at avoiding those shame spirals we get so easily trapped in. I am recommending this book for all women, whether you have a daughter or not. We could all use help learning to love ourselves better.

I would also recommend this book for men. It is an intimate look at some thoughts and feelings that a woman you love is probably struggling with but may not be able to articulate.

Beloved,

As was announced on Sunday April 15th, Mark and I have been appointed to serve at Broadway UMC in Council Bluffs, IA starting July 1. We did not ask for a move, but the invitation to serve this church is a call we could not say no to. It is a chance for us to be together on Sunday mornings and it will be the first time in 15 years that I will be living less than 4 hours away from my mom and sister.

It is hard to know the timeline of when the new pastor will be announced. On Tuesday April 17th, Rev. Kiboko met with members of the Single Board to hear their hearts for our church. The church has been presented to the Cabinet sometime April 23-25th (8 District Superintendents, the Bishop, and the Bishop assistants.) After the Cabinet prays and discerns a person to come here, that person is called and given a chance to pray. If they say yes, an Appointment Introductory Meeting (AIM) is arranged with our Single Board. This is like the one date before an arranged marriage. Both parties have a chance to say it won't work but there have to be some very compelling reasons and honestly? That usually doesn't happen. After the AIM, the date for the announcement is that so that all the churches involved receive the news of the move on the same day. It may be that by the time you see this letter, an announcement has been made or will be made shortly.

My plan is to work as hard as I can to make this transition as smooth as possible. You will hear (and see) shortly about some technology updates to this end. As of the writing of this letter, I do not have my moving date yet. The transition policy of the conference is that I get a week off before the moving truck arrives, and the week after they drop my stuff off. For planning purposes, COM has helped me to set my last Sunday preaching for you as June 3rd. The weekend of June 8-10th I will be in Des Moines for Annual Conference. For June 17th and June 24th Ryan Russell, Licensed Local Pastor and Associate at First UMC, lowa City will be here preaching.

Please do not hesitate to let me know how I can help you transition well. My prayer is that you will be able to receive your new pastor with even more love than you might imagine. My prayer is also that while there may be grief at this time, there will also be joy and rejoicing.
